
1) Faith Communities

- a. All faith communities were well represented.
- b. 80% of respondents have been part of the parish faith community for over 5 years.
- c. 88% of those surveyed attend Mass regularly (weekly).
- d. 90% of those surveyed worship regularly in a single Parish faith community.
- e. 26% of respondents are willing to attend other faith communities within the Parish.
- f. Only 7% of those surveyed occasionally worship outside our Parish.

This tells us the faith communities were well represented and that parishioners worship regularly within the parish faith community they feel a part of.

2) Growing in our faith

a. The reasons for attending Mass are varied as shown below.




b. 84% of parishioners felt that their spiritual needs were being met.

This tells us that the majority of those attending Mass on a regular basis are growing in their faith.

3) Parishioner engagement.

- a. 54% of respondents said they volunteer within the Parish.
- b. 66% of parishioners are willing to volunteer between 1 and 5 hours per week.
- c. The areas in which parishioners are willing to serve is varied as seen below.



This tells us that we have a strong and vibrant parish. Our level of parishioner engagement is very good within the parish, but we have room for improvement.

4) Evangelization

- a. 56% of respondents know folks who no longer attend Mass.
- b. 45% of parishioners are willing to invite people back to Mass.

This tell us that more emphasis should be placed on preparation and training to help parishioners with evangelization. That is, first helping one another invite people we know to encounter Christ and second, having something to invite new or returning people to.
